#### Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment

- Total resident and non-resident WSCH decreased 2% at 257,179.
- Total resident and non-resident unduplicated headcount decreased 2% at 21,311.
- Resident WSCH is down 3% at 220,294, while non-resident WSCH is up 4% at 36,885.
- International student WSCH is up 2% at 31,285.

#### Students who Applied and Enrolled in Winter 2014

- 31% of applicants reported in the past year, they participated in activities that served their community from once a week to once a month.
- 53% of applicants reported their family income to be below \$50,000 per year.
- 58% of applicants reported they speak a language other than English at home; Spanish was the top language followed by Vietnamese then Chinese.

#### Online Education

- Total online education estimated WSCH is down 4% at 21,293.
- Online education headcount is up 5% from 3,594 to 3,756.
- Online education course enrollment is down 3% at 5,053.
- The CAOS program ran 18 sections in winter 2013 accounting for 943 enrollments; the CAOS program is not included in winter 2014 rates.

## Zip Code Groupings – Targeted Populations

- For African American students, enrollment from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga increased 6%, while enrollment from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto decreased 9%, and enrollment from San Jose Other decreased 6%.
- For Latino students, enrollment from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga decreased 1%, while enrollment from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto increased 9%, and enrollment from San Jose Other increased 6%.

## Continuing Students by Ethnicity

Continuing student enrollment accounts for students who were enrolled in the fall and returned the next quarter. These students are our largest proportion of enrollment each quarter and are a proxy for students who persist from quarter to quarter without dropping out.

- African American continuing student headcount decreased 4% from 711 to 684.
- Asian student continuing headcount increased 2% from 6,395 to 6,492.
- Latino/a student continuing headcount increased 8% from 3,696 to 4,009.
